What is Prayer Walking?

Prayer walking is simply walking and talking with God. The two go hand in hand. It blesses both the one who prays and the one for whom they pray. It is the way we “pray without ceasing.”

How can you prayer walk the First Baptist campus?

This brochure gives you prayer requests from fifteen different ministry areas of First Baptist. Each ministry is represented with a PRAYER STOP. Specific, ongoing prayer needs are posted at each stop. These prayer needs may change from time to time. You may pick up an updated Prayer Path Companion in the Sanctuary narthex and the Media Library.

Who can use this prayer tool?

Individuals and groups are encouraged to prayer walk the campus. You may take a Sunday School class, a mission group, or walk alone with God. You may visit each PRAYER STOP and lift up the needs listed by each ministry before the Lord.

When can you prayer walk?

These PRAYER STOPS are available 24 hours a day. You may take a few minutes out of a small group time and walk as many stops, in any order or any building, as you have time. Please refer to inside map. Those who are unable to walk can use this brochure and the Prayer Path Companion as a guide for their personal or small group prayers.

Where can you prayer walk?

You may prayer walk any place, any time. Please remember to prayer walk your neighborhood, your children’s school, your workplace. Prayer is not an option—it is to be your life.

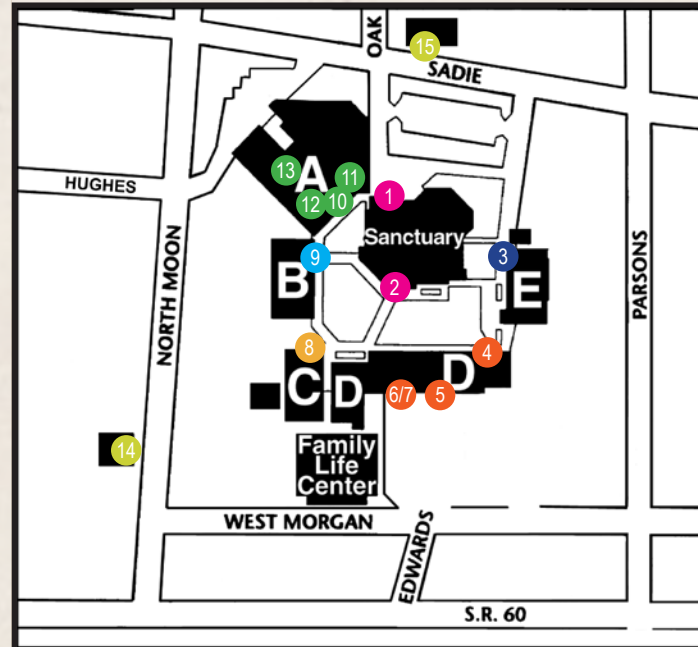
